Core Value	Month	Theme
T (Teaching)	September	"Ignite the Spark: Teach What You Know" "Journey to the Classroom" —Guest Speak: retired educator shares their story
R (Recreation)	October	"Fall Festivities and Fun" "Game On" —Team-building game night or competition "Recess Rewind" —Outdoor childhood games to build the community. "Wellness Week" —Focus on fun, stress-relieving activities like yoga, coloring, or laughter games.
A (Appreciation)	November	"Gratitude in Action" "Thankful Thursday" —Write and deliver thank-you notes to school staff. "Pop-Up Fundraiser" —Quick, creative on-the-spot fundraising challenge "Adopt-a Teacher" —Surprise a teacher with small tokens of appreciation.
F (Fundraising)	December	"Season of Giving" "Pitch It" —Shark Tank-style fundraiser idea presentations "Pop-Up Fundraiser" —Quick, creative on-the-spot fundraising challenge "Fundraising Fair" —Plan multiple stations for a fundraiser event (games, crafts, snacks)
L (Leadership)	January	"New Year, New Leaders" "Lead Like Me" —Personality styles and leadership strengths activity. "Step Into Leadership" —Officer panel or alumni leadership Q&A. "Leaders in Actions" —Shadow a leader in your school or community and report back.
E (Educational Awareness)	February	"Career Pathways & Passions" "Career Clusters 101" —What type of careers are inside education besides teaching? "Beyond High School" —Explore options: tech schools, college, apprenticeships. "Pathways Panel" —Invite professionals from various fields in education to share their journeys.
S (Service)	March	"Spring Into Service" "Hearts & Hands" —Make care kits or cards for a local organization. "Serve Your School" —Identify a need on campus and create a solution. "Service Scavenger Hunt" —Complete small acts of kindness in teams.
