Core Value	Month	Theme
<b>T</b> (Teaching)	September	<b>“Ignite the Spark: Teach What You Know”</b> <b>“Journey to the Classroom”</b> —Guest Speak: retired educator shares their story
<b>R</b> (Recreation)	October	<b>“Fall Festivities and Fun”</b> <b>“Game On”</b> —Team-building game night or competition <b>“Recess Rewind”</b> —Outdoor childhood games to build the community. <b>“Wellness Week”</b> —Focus on fun, stress-relieving activities like yoga, coloring, or laughter games.
<b>A</b> (Appreciation)	November	<b>“Gratitude in Action”</b> <b>“Thankful Thursday”</b> —Write and deliver thank-you notes to school staff. <b>“Pop-Up Fundraiser”</b> —Quick, creative on-the-spot fundraising challenge <b>“Adopt-a Teacher”</b> —Surprise a teacher with small tokens of appreciation.
<b>F</b> (Fundraising)	December	<b>“Season of Giving”</b> <b>“Pitch It”</b> —Shark Tank-style fundraiser idea presentations <b>“Pop-Up Fundraiser”</b> —Quick, creative on-the-spot fundraising challenge <b>“Fundraising Fair”</b> —Plan multiple stations for a fundraiser event (games, crafts, snacks)
<b>L</b> (Leadership)	January	<b>“New Year, New Leaders”</b> <b>“Lead Like Me”</b> —Personality styles and leadership strengths activity. <b>“Step Into Leadership”</b> —Officer panel or alumni leadership Q&A. <b>“Leaders in Actions”</b> —Shadow a leader in your school or community and report back.
<b>E</b> (Educational Awareness)	February	<b>“Career Pathways &amp; Passions”</b> <b>“Career Clusters 101”</b> —What type of careers are inside education besides teaching? <b>“Beyond High School”</b> —Explore options: tech schools, college, apprenticeships. <b>“Pathways Panel”</b> —Invite professionals from various fields in education to share their journeys.
<b>S</b> (Service)	March	<b>“Spring Into Service”</b> <b>“Hearts &amp; Hands”</b> —Make care kits or cards for a local organization. <b>“Serve Your School”</b> —Identify a need on campus and create a solution. <b>“Service Scavenger Hunt”</b> —Complete small acts of kindness in teams.
