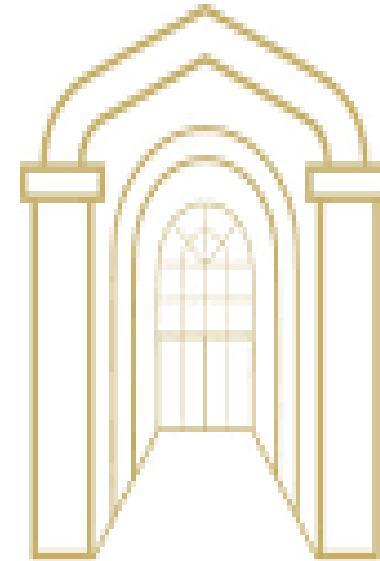

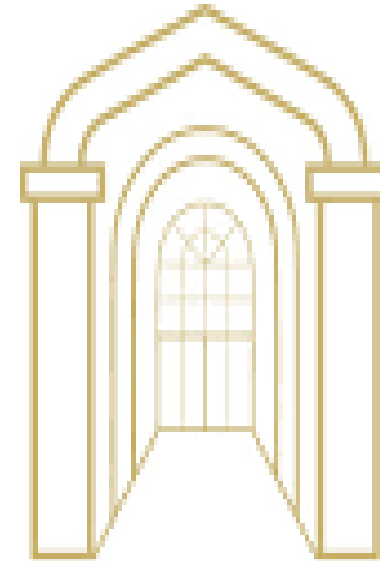

MGCCC- New Century Skills – Expert and Master Scholar Awards



These scholarships are awarded to Mississippi residents who are “first-time to enter college” freshmen, have a high-school diploma, and have completed a two-year secondary CTE program OR *place first, second, or third in a state or national student organization competition recognized by the Mississippi Department of Education** with an overall high school average of B or above.

Hinds Community College

A two-year, half-tuition scholarship: the award amount is equivalent to half of the published rate of full-time tuition and is awarded per semester for up to four consecutive semesters, excluding summer terms.



Pearl River Community College



\$875 per semester

This scholarship is awarded to a student who completed a two-year Career-Technical program at a high school within the state of Mississippi and who has an overall grade point average of 3.00 upon high school graduation. The student must enroll full-time at PRCC (at least 15 credit hours) within one academic year of high school graduation.

Pearl River Community College



\$1,750 per semester

This scholarship is awarded to a student who completed a two-year Career-Technical program at a high school within the state of Mississippi and who has an overall grade point average of 3.50 upon high school graduation. The student must enroll full-time at PRCC (at least 15 credit hours) within one academic year of high school graduation.

Northeast Mississippi Community College

The Northeast Promise

The Northeast Promise scholarship is a pilot last-dollar scholarship for tuition and mandatory fees for residents of Northeast's district who are enrolled in a career and technical education program of study.

Must reside in Alcorn, Prentiss, Tippah, Tishomingo, or Union County

Special/Career Incentive

- **Semester Value: \$1,825**
Two-Year Value: \$7,300
- A tuition scholarship for students who are first place winner in DECA, FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, HOSA, Skills USA, TSA, or any other nationally affiliated career/technical organization on the state and/or national level.



Northeast Mississippi Community College

Career Incentive

- **Semester Value: \$912.50**
Two-Year Value: \$3,650
- A one-half (1/2) tuition scholarship for students who are a second or third place winner in DECA, FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, HOSA, Skills USA, TSA, or any other nationally affiliated career/technical organization on state and/or national level.

Career and Technical (CTE) Scholarships

- **Scholarship criteria:**
- Overall high school GPA 3.5+: \$7,500.00 to be awarded over four (4) regular semesters
- Overall high school GPA 3.0-3.499: \$3,760.00 to be awarded over four (4) regular semesters

Holmes Community College

SkillsUSA Scholarship

- Scholarships may be awarded to 1st place district and/or state SkillsUSA contest winners in specific Career/Technical areas of individual competition or in team competition that is discipline-specific.

VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

- **Amount:** \$1,800 per semester.
- **Criteria:** Enrolled in a high school vocational center in a county from Noxubee, Lowndes, Lauderdale, Clay, Oktibbeha, or Kemper. | Recommendation by the Vocational Director. | Only one award per Vocational Center.

MS Works Career-Tech

- The Mississippi Works Career-Tech Scholarship program provides tuition assistance to community college students who are enrolled in approved Career and Technical Education Certificate and Associate in Applied Science degree programs identified through sector analysis to meet the workforce demands of the state.

CAREER INCENTIVE

- **\$6,200** (up to \$1,550 per semester)
- Student must be a first-place state or national winner in competition.
- Student must be actively pursuing an Associate of Arts or Associate of Applied Science degree.

CAREER EDUCATION

- **\$3,100** (\$775 per semester)
- Student must be a second- or third-place state or national winner in competition.
- Student must be actively pursuing an Associate of Arts or Associate of Applied Science degree.
