

Completer Award

Purpose

The Completer Award recognizes Educators Rising members who have demonstrated commitment to the teaching profession through successful participation in the Educator Preparation Career & Technical Program. This recognition celebrates students who have completed or are completing the Educator Preparation CTE pathway and have maintained active involvement in Educators Rising.

The Completer Award recognizes dedication to both the Educator Preparation pathway and Educators Rising and is intended to honor students who have actively engaged in preparing for a future career in education.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Completer Award, students must:

- Be currently enrolled in or have successfully completed **Year Two of the Educator Preparation Career & Technical Program**.
- Be a sophomore, junior, or senior during the current school year.
- Have been an affiliated Educators Rising member for a minimum of **two (2) consecutive years**.
- Be a currently affiliated Educators Rising member in good standing.
- Be registered and present at the Mississippi Educators Rising State Leadership Conference.

Submission Process

Advisors are responsible for verifying student eligibility and submitting all required information by the designated deadline.

Verification

Eligibility will be verified through:

- Educator Preparation program enrollment records.
- Educators Rising membership records.
- State Leadership Conference registration records.

Advisors may be asked to verify student eligibility prior to recognition.

Award Recognition

Eligible students will receive:

- A Mississippi Educators Rising Completer Award
- Recognition during the Mississippi Educators Rising State Leadership Conference Awards Session
- Recognition as students who have demonstrated a sustained commitment to becoming future educators

Award Type

Recognition Award (Non-Competitive)

All students who meet the eligibility requirements will be recognized.
